***Scope:***

Due to geographic challenges, specific target markets and individual needs based on a variety of factors, the WRMCA has divided Wisconsin and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan into five legislative regions. The legislative Committee will address specific legislative conditions.

**Persons Responsible:** Five regional programs are developed and overseen by the legislative committee, chaired by either a producer or associate members. The legislative chair implements the legislative regional programs and facilitates member efforts.



### **REGION 1 – Southwest Region**

Columbia, Crawford, Dane, Dodge, Grant, Green, Iowa, Jefferson, Juneau, La Crosse, Lafayette, Monroe, Richland, Rock, Sauk and Vernon counties.

### **REGION 2 - Southeast Region**

Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Walworth, Washington and Waukesha counties.

### **REGION 3 - Northeast Region**

Brown, Calumet, Door, Fond du Lac, Kewaunee, Manitowoc, Marinette, Oconto, Outagamie, Sheboygan and Winnebago counties.

### **REGION 4 - North Central Region**

Adams, Florence, Forest, Green Lake, Iron, Langlade, Lincoln, Marathon, Marquette, Menominee, Oneida, Portage, Price, Shawano, Vilas, Waupaca, Waushara, Wood counties and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan.

### **REGION 5 - Northwest region**

Ashland, Barron, Bayfield, Buffalo, Burnett, Chippewa, Clark, Douglas, Dunn, Eau Claire, Jackson, Pepin, Pierce, Polk, Rusk, Sawyer, St. Croix, Taylor, Trempealeau and Washburn counties.
