

# Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association Scholarship

1. This scholarship is established to help support students planning to obtain a degree in the concrete-related programs at Middle Tennessee State University, Alpena Community College in Michigan, and Rhodes State College in Ohio. The WRMCA reserves the right to expand the list of schools as programs are developed, however the goal of the scholarship program is to seek out and assist students seeking further education to enter the ready-mixed concrete industry.
2. Applications must be postmarked by March 1, 2006 for the scholarship being awarded for the 2006 – 2007 school year. No exceptions will be made.
3. The Scholarship is available to:
  - residents of Wisconsin and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan
  - members, or family of the Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association members.
4. The scholarship will be awarded in March 2006.
5. No person may receive more than one award in her or his lifetime. (This provision can be reviewed and overturned by the WRMCA Scholarship Committee on a case-by-case basis.)
6. Applicant must be a member of the senior class, a graduate of a secondary school, or a current college student, including those who are older than high school age desiring to continue their education.
7. Instructions for applying for the Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association's Scholarship:
  - A. Fill out the application form completely. Use extra paper if necessary.
  - B. Send to the Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association's Scholarship Committee, 16 N Carroll Street Suite 925 Madison, WI 53703 with the following:
    1. 250 to 500 word essay on why you want to obtain an advanced degree in a concrete-related program
    2. Two letters of recommendation from persons unrelated to the applicant who can attest to the applicant's character and academic ability.
    3. Copy of the applicant's most recent grade transcript.
8. The Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association will award a \$5,000 scholarship if the winner chooses to go to Middle Tennessee State University and enroll in their Concrete Management Program. A \$2,500 scholarship will be given if the winner plans to enroll in the concrete technology program at Alpena Community College in Alpena, Michigan, or the concrete technology program at Rhodes State College. The Scholarship will be divided between the first two consecutive semesters to help ensure the student will stay enrolled in the program for at least an entire academic year. The scholarship will be paid to the student at the end of each semester. The student is required to submit a copy of a paid receipt and their grades from the school each semester to the Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association to receive payment. The student will be expected to refund the scholarship if he/she does not complete the entire first year course of study.
