

Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association Membership Scholarship

1. This scholarship is established to help support immediate family members of Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association members who are planning to obtain a degree in a concrete-related curriculum such as the Concrete Industry Management programs offered at Middle Tennessee State University, New Jersey Institute of Technology, California State University at Chico and Arizona State University in Phoenix. Other eligible programs would include those at Alpena Community College in Michigan and Rhodes State College in Ohio. The Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association reserves the right to expand the list of schools as programs are developed. The goal of the scholarship program is to seek out and assist students seeking further education to enter the ready-mixed concrete industry.
2. The Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association will award a \$5,000 scholarship if the winner chooses to go to Middle Tennessee State University, New Jersey Institute of Technology, California State University at Chico or Arizona State University in Phoenix and enroll in their Concrete Management Program or Alpena Community College in Alpena, Michigan or Rhodes State College in Ohio and enroll in their Concrete Technology Program. A \$2,500 scholarship will be given if the winner plans to enroll in a school of their choice. The Scholarship will be sent to the winners chosen school to be divided between the first two consecutive semesters. The student is required to submit a copy of their transcripts from the school each semester to the Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association to help ensure the student will stay enrolled in the program for at least an entire academic year. The student will be expected to refund the scholarship if he/she does not complete the entire first year course of study.
3. Applications must be postmarked by November 30, 2007 for the scholarship being awarded for the 2008-2009 school year. No exceptions will be made.
4. The Scholarship is available to:
 - residents of Wisconsin and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan
 - immediate family members of a Producer or Associate member of the Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association.
5. The winner of the 2007-2008 competition will be announced during the WRMCA's Annual Convention held in March 2008 in Madison, WI. The first place winner and one of his or her parents or guardians will be invited to the association's convention and be guests at the convention's business meeting.
6. No person may receive more than one Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association scholarship award in her or his lifetime (This provision can be reviewed and overturned by the Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association Scholarship Committee on a case-by-case basis).
7. Applicant must be an immediate family member of a Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association member and a member of the senior class, a graduate of a secondary school, or a current college student, including those who are older than high school age desiring to continue their education.
8. Instructions for applying for the Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association's Membership Scholarship:
 - A. Fill out the application form completely. Use extra paper if necessary.
 - B. Send to the Wisconsin Ready Mixed Concrete Association's Scholarship Committee, 16 N Carroll Street Suite 925 Madison, WI 53703 with the following:
 1. 250 to 500 word essay on why you want to obtain a degree or advanced degree in a concrete-related program
 2. Two letters of recommendation from persons unrelated to the applicant who can attest to the applicant's character and academic ability.
 3. Copy of the applicant's most recent grade transcript.
